## Enrollment Application Checklist:

### Step One:

Visit [www.CherryHillsChristian.org/enrollment/enroll.php](http://www.CherryHillsChristian.org/enrollment/enroll.php) and complete the online inquiry form.

### Step Two:

Once you have completed the online enrollment submission form please print the following from our Forms page and return to the Enrollment Department beginning January 26, 2012:

- ENROLLMENT APPLICATION** | Please complete this form for each enrolling student. Please provide all requested information. We are unable to accept incomplete forms.
- PRESCHOOL ENROLLMENT REQUEST** | (One per student) See the 2012-2013 PreSchool Tuition page inside. Make your enrollment choices carefully.
- MEDICAL RELEASE** | Please complete and sign one form per student.
- FAMILY PHOTOGRAPH** | For security purposes, please attach a recent, color photograph of your entire family with names written on the back (in non-smear pen) to assist our staff in identifying the members of your child's family. Photos need to be clear and large enough to readily identify family members. More than one photo may be used to create a "collage" of family members if necessary.
- APPLICATION FEE** | Include payment of a **non-refundable** application fee of \$75 for the first new student, \$25 for each additional student.

### Please Note:

Upon placement of your child in a program, you will receive email notification of placement and instructions to visit our ParentsWeb site to complete the rest of the forms to confirm enrollment. All forms will need to be signed and returned within 10 business days along with the first month's tuition for the 2012-2013 Program Year.

### Payment Options

CHC offers families three (3) different tuition payment plans. Additional details regarding payment requirements, tuition amounts and deadlines will appear on the CHC Financial Agreement specific to each student.

#### Pay-In-Advance

**PIA Option #1:** One check or credit card (Visa or MasterCard) is submitted for the entire annual Tuition plus the one-time Supply Fee. Payment is due by July 25, 2012.

**PIA Option #2:** Two checks are submitted (no credit cards with this option). The first payment is for one-half of the annual Tuition plus one half of the Supply Fee and is due July 25, 2012. The second payment is for same dollar amount and is due January 23, 2013.

#### Bank Auto-debits

**Auto-Debit 23rd of the month.** Preschool has eight (8) Tuition payments beginning September 2012. In addition, on October 23, 2012, one extra debit per student is taken for the PreSchool Supply Fee.

# 2012-2013 PreSchool Program Highlights

At Cherry Hills Christian PreSchool we believe in Christian education as demonstrated in our commitment to using Christian principles in all aspects of learning. We desire to create a partnership with parents within an environment that will strengthen their families and encourage growth in their spiritual journey. Innovative teacher-compiled curriculum includes developmentally appropriate learning activities that engage children through hands-on learning opportunities. Highlights of our programs include:

- Accreditation through the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).
- Daily learning centers and activities include language and literacy, math, science, creative art, fine and gross motor
- Weekly music class
- Social emotional training
- Spiritual development
- Full Time Nurse on site
- Regular teacher communication via emails and parent newsletters
- Family Events that promote community like our Annual All School Social, Scholastic Book Fair, Thanksgiving Feasts, Christmas program, Parent Time (opportunities for parents to meet other parents in the classroom), Parent-Teacher Conferences, PreSchool Parent Council, Field Day, and a Prekindergarten Graduation Ceremony.

PreSchool and Prekindergarten programs are offered to include half day or full day learning opportunities (via our Enrichment programs). Enrichment classes extend your child's learning experiences, enhancing the curriculum with the same high standards as our PreSchool classes. Choose from two to four days, maximum. For enrollment, your child should be within the program's age range on or before September 15th. Children should be toilet-trained or close by age three, unless permission is given by the Director.

Kid's Day Out is offered for children two years of age. A structured day of play-based learning, children engage in many hands-on activities while learning social skills in a loving environment. Children bring their lunch to eat with their classmates and a rest period is provided. Choose up to three days, maximum.

## Admission Procedures

1. Parents must attend the PreSchool New Enrollment Information Night on January 23, 2012, OR attend a tour of our PreSchool. Tours are offered every Wednesday (when school is in session) at 9:30 a.m. Parents do not need to make an appointment for Wednesday tours. If you need to schedule a tour on another day, please contact the Enrollment Department at 303-325-8175.
2. Parents must complete and return an enrollment application, including all required documents, family photo and application fee for each enrolling child.
3. After the PreSchool New Enrollment Information Night (or parent tour) applications will be accepted beginning January 26, 2012 and continue to be accepted through the spring and summer. Applications will NOT be time stamped. Placement will be done as outlined in the Admissions Policies below.

## Admission Policies

# Our Faith

The Holy Bible, being the infallible Word of God, requires our unreserved submission in all areas of life. 3. The Holy Spirit has come to glorify Christ and to apply the saving work of Christ to our hearts. He convicts us of sin and draws us to the Savior. Indwelling our hearts, he gives us new life, empowers and imparts us with gifts for service, and seals us for the day of redemption.
4. Being estranged from God, and condemned by our sinfulness, our salvation is wholly dependent upon the work of God's free grace. God credits his righteousness to those who put their faith in Christ alone for their salvation, and thereby justifies them in his sight. Only those born of the Holy Spirit, by receiving Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, become children of God and heirs of eternal life.
5. The true Church is composed of all persons who, through saving faith in Jesus Christ and the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit, are united together in the body of Christ.
6. Jesus Christ will come again to the earth—personally, visibly, and bodily—to judge the living and the dead and to consummate history and the eternal plan of God.
7. The Lord Jesus Christ commands all believers to proclaim the Gospel throughout the world and to make disciples of all nations. Obedience to the Great Commission requires total commitment to "him who loved us and gave himself for us."
