ENROLLMENT APPLICATION PROCESS

STEP ONE

Visit www.cherryhillschristian.org/enrollment/enroll.php and complete our online inquiry form.

STEP TWO

Once you have submitted the online form, print the following from our Forms page, complete and return the following in person to CHC:

- ENROLLMENT APPLICATION** | Fully complete this form for each enrolling student.
- STUDENT INFORMATION GRADES K-5** | Fully complete this form for each enrolling student.
- QUESTIONNAIRE** | Complete this form for each enrolling student so that we may better understand your child's needs and interests.
- MEDICAL RELEASE GRADES K-8** | Fully complete this form for each enrolling student.
- STUDENT APPRAISAL OR PRESCHOOL EVALUATION** | Give a signed Student Appraisal or PreSchool Evaluation form to your child's most recent teacher. Ask your child's teacher to fax this form in order to expedite completion of your child's application to 1-866-821-7982 (toll free).
- REPORT CARD** | Include a copy of your child's most recent report card (students entering grades 1-5).
- TRANSCRIPT RELEASE** | Complete and sign Transcript Release form being sure to include all addresses and phone numbers (only for students entering grades 1-5).
- APPLICATION FEES** | Include payment of appropriate fees per child, which are **non-refundable**: Kindergarten- Grade 5 | \$100 (which includes \$50 application fee and \$50 evaluation fee).
- FAMILY PHOTOGRAPH** | For security purposes, please attach a recent, color photograph of your entire family with names written on back (in non-smear pen) to assist our staff in identifying the members of your child's family. Photos need to be clear and large enough to readily identify family members. More than one photo may be used to create a "collage" of family members if necessary.

Applications are not considered complete until all of the above materials are received.

Our Mission

Cherry Hills Christian is committed to honoring Christ by teaching, encouraging, training and grounding students in God's truth within a dynamic, academic environment. Heart, Soul, Mind, Strength.

Our Faith

The Holy Bible, being the infallible Word of God, requires our unreserved submission in all areas of life. All Scripture, as written in the sixty-six books of the Old and New Testaments, serves as a unified witness to God's redemptive acts, culminating in the incarnation of the Living Word, the Lord Jesus Christ. Only those born of the Holy Spirit, by receiving Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, become children of God and heirs of eternal life.
5. The true Church is composed of all persons who, through saving faith in Jesus Christ and the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit, are united together in the body of Christ.
6. Jesus Christ will come again to the earth—personally, visibly, and bodily—to judge the living and the dead and to consummate history and the eternal plan of God.
7. The Lord Jesus Christ commands all believers to proclaim the Gospel throughout the world and to make disciples of all nations. Obedience to the Great Commission requires total commitment to "him who loved us and gave himself for us."

**Due at Enrollment and every subsequent January for Reenrollment and is non-refundable. Families (re)enrolling three or more students in grades K-8 will be billed \$250 per student. **One time fee for new students ONLY and is non-refundable.*

Payment Options

CHC offers three (3) different tuition payment plans. Parents download, print, complete, and submit a Financial Agreement for each child being enrolled.

Pay-In-Advance

Option #1: One check or credit card (Visa or Mastercard) is submitted for the entire annual Tuition. Payment is due by July 23, 2010.

Option #2: Two checks are submitted (no credit cards with this option). The first payment is for one-half of the annual Tuition and is due by July 23, 2010. The second payment for the same dollar amount is due by January 24, 2011.

Bank Auto-Debits

Auto-Debit-23rd of the month: (no credit cards with this option). K-7 has eleven (11) Tuition payments starting in July and ending in June (skip January - reenrollment). Grade 8 has eleven (11) Tuition payments starting in July and ending in May (do not skip January).

Fifth Grade Outdoor Education Fee

Outdoor Education for grade 5 is billed separately in August.

Kindergarten Enrichment Supply Fee

Kindergarten Enrichment students pay an annual \$55 Supply Fee (to PreSchool).

Scholarships (Financial Aid)

Scholarships may be granted to CHC families with students in grades 1-8. Scholarship funds are acquired by CHC through fundraising projects and donor gifts. Awards are based upon the following: a) need, b) the number of qualified applicants, and c) funds available. Families with students enrolled in the Discovery Program may also apply for scholarship funds. Scholarship packets for 2010-2011 school year may be picked up in the Business Office between Monday, March 1 and Monday, May 3, 2010.

All families with three or more children enrolled in K-8 will automatically receive discounted tuition for their third child and for any other additional children. Full Tuition rates apply to the first and second children; then the following award amounts would apply:

\$1,000 Discount: 3rd child \$2,000 Discount: 4th child or more

Admission Information

Admission Procedures

1. Parents must attend the CHC New Enrollment Information Night on January 25, 2010 at 6:30 p.m., OR arrange an appointment for a tour and class observation by calling 303-325-8175 before the prospective student visits the school.
2. Parents must complete and return an application, including all materials and appropriate fees, for each enrolling student .
3. Every prospective Kindergarten student must complete a Readiness Evaluation. Parents will be called to schedule this appointment after the completed application has been received. PreSchool is not a requirement for admission to Kindergarten.
4. All prospective students for Grades 1–8 are required to complete a student visitation. The student will visit the classroom for a full day from 8:10 a.m. to 3:20 p.m. During their visit, students will complete a general academic evaluation. Visits begin in February for the following school year. As space becomes available, parents will be called to schedule a student visitation. The entire completed application, along with the child's Previous School Appraisal, most recent report card or special testing results (if any), must be submitted prior to scheduling the student visitation.
5. After the CHC New Enrollment Information Night (or parent tour/observation), student visitation and evaluation are completed, a family interview (to include parents, applicant(s) and administrator) is scheduled. All these events must take place before March 1 for your child's application to be considered in the first round of placement. However, registration will continue throughout the spring and summer.

Admission Policies

Cherry Hills Christian admits students of any race, color, national origin and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admission policies, scholarship programs and athletic and other school-administered programs. However, we reserve the right to prioritize placement of applicants into available openings according to any of the following criteria:

- Birth date
- Boy/girl ratio
- Family interview
- Space availability
- Academic readiness
- Parent is currently a staff member of Cherry Hills Christian or Cherry Hills Community Church
- Parental involvement in full-time Christian ministry
- Parent is currently a member of Cherry Hills Community Church
- Sibling is currently enrolled in Cherry Hills Christian School
(PreSchool, Elementary or Middle)

Children who are five years old by September 15 are eligible for Kindergarten. We do not make exceptions for age and ability. Every student's admission is contingent upon the above factors.
